The Contented Cat and The Crafty Quilter challenge all quilters to make a small quilt using a simple block. This is a design challenge to discover what entrants can create using very simple design constraints. You can use any fabrics you wish.

1. You must use the 4" block as shown on the front cover. The block is drawn to size and you can use it to make your templates. How you use the block is up to you.
2. There must be some appliqué bias work on the quilt. Ideally this should be self-made bias.
3. The finished size of the quilt must be approx. 1m square.
4. A 3" hanging sleeve must be attached to the back together with a label with your name and address.
5. The quilt should have three layers and must be quilted.
6. Entry is made by completing the form overleaf which must be sent with your finished quilt by 31 October 2008 to The Crafty Quilter together with a cheque for £2.50 to cover return postage costs.
7. The entries will be judged by independent judges and their decision will be final.
