

Naturescapes Quilt

(pattern adapted from a quilt designed by Nancy Mahoney for Hoffman Fabrics)

Fabric Requirements

4 Scenic panels # E600 from the Naturescapes collection

$\frac{3}{4}$ m #PN008 from the A Walk in the Woods collection

$\frac{3}{4}$ m #E903 bark/stone fabric from the Naturescapes collection for sashing and borders

Cutting Instructions

Cut the scenic panels to make four strips 12" wide

Cut 2 x 12" strips from the light Walk in the Woods fabric.

From each strip cut

- 1 rectangle 12" by 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
- 1 rectangle 12" by 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
- 1 rectangle 12" by 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ "

From the bark/stone fabric cut

- 7 strips measuring 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " by 44"
- 6 strips measuring 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " by 44"

Refer to the picture above

1. Take a 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " bark sashing strip sew this to the bottom of a scenic panel. Trim. Sew a 12" by 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the sashing strip
2. Join a sashing strip to each end of the next scenic panel. Trim to fit. Join a 12" by 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the top sashing strip and a 12" by 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the bottom sashing strip.
3. Repeat step 2 but sew a 12" by 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the top sashing strip and a 12" by 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the bottom of the sashing strip.
4. Repeat step 1 but sew a sashing strip to the top of a scenic panel and then add a 12" by 17 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the top of this.
5. Join the remaining 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " sashing strips together.
6. Arrange the four units as shown in the picture and join them together with a long 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " sashing strip between each new scenic panel ensuring that the panels are all upright. Press
7. Join the 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " border strips together and join to the edge of the quilt.
