

The Wave Railfence Wall Hanging

Finished Size: 40" square

Yardage Estimate

$\frac{1}{2}$ m x 2 fabrics from the
Wave Collection from

Fabri-quilt

$\frac{3}{4}$ m x 1 fabric from the
Wave collection (the extra
fabric is to be used for the
border)

This quilt uses the yellow,
orange and red colours.



Cut six strips measuring 2 ½" by 44" from each of the three fabrics. Take one strip of each of the fabrics and join them together along the 44" length. Press the seams in one direction.



Next cut a pieced square across the width of this pieced strip measuring 6 ½" by 6 ½".

Cut six squares from the pieced strip.

Make a further 30 blocks in the same manner with the remaining five sets of strips.

Lay out the blocks as shown above before joining them together. When starting a new row move the first block along one position each time otherwise you will have columns of the same block in the quilt.

From the border fabric cut four further strips measuring 2½” by 44”. Join one strip to each side of the pieced centre, ensuring that the middle of the strip is in the middle of the pieced centre. If you wish mitre the corners of the border by folding the quilt right sides together and drawing a sewing line at 45° by laying your ruler on the border as shown below. Sew along this line and then trim the excess to leave a ¼” seam allowance.



Press and quilt as desired.
