

Breaking Waves Quilt

Fabric Required

1.25m The Wave fabric # 907
(12 colours available)

1.25m Shimmer fabric #1785
(7 colours available)

The fabrics and kits to make this quilt are available to order via our website www.craftyquilter.co.uk

This quilt is very simple and quick to make and will suit all skill levels.



Finished Size: 51 ½" x 56"

Take the Wave fabric and cut four strips from it across the width of the fabric measuring 9 ½" by 44". Lay each strip out and make three random cuts in each strip to break the waves up. Try to get the cuts as random as possible – this is not as easy as it sounds if you look at my attempt in the quilt above!

From the Shimmer fabric cut 3 strips measuring 3 ½" by 44". From these strips cut 12 sashing strips measuring 9 ½" by 3 ½".

Join a sashing strip between each of the cuts on the wave fabrics to make four pieced strips measuring 9 ½" by 50"

Cut a further 9 strips from the Shimmer fabric measuring 3 ½" by 44". Make four vertical sashing strips. You will need to add another strip each time to make these the correct length. Join the pieced strips and vertical sashing strips together. Use the remaining Shimmer strips to make the top and bottom sashing strips.

Press and quilt as desired. Cut the remainder of the Wave fabric into 1 ¼" strips to make the binding.
